

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. This Warranty applies only to the original purchaser (or owner) named on the warranty certificate.
2. This Warranty applies only to ATR tyres imported to Australia by Pirelli Tyres Australia and sold by an authorised Pirelli dealer.
3. This Warranty is only available with the purchase of 2 or more Pirelli Scorpion ATR tyres of any size. Tyres older than 5 years from the date of manufacture are not covered.
4. Pirelli reserves the right to terminate this offer at any time by prior communication on the Pirelli website.
5. The Warranty is valid when you present a Zero Hazards Certificate, within 24 months from the date of purchase and is not transferable to another vehicle.
6. Products availability is subject to change without notice. Pirelli Tyres Australia reserves the right to reject claims for discontinued or out of stock products.
7. **Free tyre replacement applies for:**
 - a. Damage caused by tyre collision with gutters, kerbs or potholes that is not reparable.
 - b. The replacement of the tyre is free of charge only for the vehicle specified in the Zero Hazards Certificate and only for the first 50% of the useable tread-life of the tyre. Any associated fitment costs shall be borne by the purchaser.
8. **Tyre replacement does not apply for:**
 - a. Damage that can be repaired, such as a nail penetrating the tread, cuts and punctures. Any repair costs involved shall be borne by the purchaser.
 - b. Damage caused by an act of vandalism; theft; willful abuse; neglect due to improper inflation or overloading; running the tyres deflated; flat-spotting; tyre chain damage; improper use or operation; improper mounting or demounting; misuse; misapplication; use of an incorrect rim; negligence; tyre spinning; tyre alteration; racing or competition; non-tarmac roads; failure to

rotate properly or regularly or to properly maintain the tyres; vehicle misalignment or other vehicle conditions, defects; worn suspension components.

- c. Damage resulting from fire; vehicle accident or collision; chemical contamination; externally generated heat; vehicle lightning strike; water or other material trapped inside the tyre during mounting.

9. How to register:

To activate and receive the Zero Hazards Certificate, the purchaser has to register within 30 days from the purchase date via one of the following methods:

- a. Via the Pirelli website: go to www.pirelli.com.au complete the registration form and upload a scanned copy of the purchase invoice.
- b. Via email: complete the form below and email it along with a scanned copy of the purchase invoice to marketing.au@pirelli.com.
- c. Via mail: complete the form below and post it along with a copy of the purchase invoice to Pirelli Tyres Australia, GPO Box 327, Sydney, NSW, 2001.

10. How to claim a tyre:

To lodge a claim for a registered tyre, present the Zero Hazards Certificate and the original purchase invoice to the authorised dealer where the tyre was purchased. All claims are limited to the number of tyres purchased.

- 11. The program is offered to private individuals only and not for companies or commercially used vehicles.
- 12. Pirelli reserves the right to inspect damaged tyres before providing a free replacement tyre.
- 13. Pirelli accepts no responsibility for any injury to persons or damage to any vehicle as a result of the Pirelli tyres being damaged.
- 14. To the extent permitted by law, liabilities for consequential damages are disclaimed. In no case shall Pirelli Tyres Australia Pty Ltd's liability exceed the original cost of the purchased tyres.
- 15. In case of successful claim a new Zero Hazards Certificate cannot be issued for the replacement tyre.
